

## **Aboriginal, Torres Strait Island, Māori or Pacific Travel Scholarships to the 2026 CSANZ Annual Scientific Meeting**

The purpose of the Travel Scholarships is to assist Aboriginal, Torres Strait Island, Māori or Pacific members of CSANZ to attend the 2026 CSANZ Annual Scientific Meeting (ASM) to be held in Sydney, New South Wales from 06 – 09 August. The award will enable talented individuals to attend the ASM to further develop research and clinical knowledge and expertise and to build professional networks.

### **Award details**

The value of each award will differ depending on the budget requested, place of residence and number of applications received.

### **Eligibility**

- Aboriginal, Torres Strait Island, Māori or Pacific People who are current financial Members of CSANZ at the time of applying for the Travelling Fellowship and are registered to attend the 2026 CSANZ ASM in Brisbane.
- Working or studying in a clinical area of cardiology or cardiothoracic surgery or working in an area where there is a large caseload of patients with cardiac conditions, or a researcher in the area of cardiology.
- Applicants must reside outside of the State in which the ASM is being held.

Note - Applicants are not required to have an abstract accepted for presentation at the ASM.

### **Selection Criteria:**

1. Clinical areas of work or study
2. How attending the 2026 CSANZ ASM will benefit their clinical practice and/or research.
3. How attending the 2026 CSANZ ASM will add to the applicant's knowledge base and/or career.
4. How the applicant can contribute to CSANZ and its members.

Preference will be given to those who have not previously attended a CSANZ Annual Scientific Meeting. Applications will be assessed by the CSANZ Aboriginal Torres Strait Islander Māori and Pacific Council Executive.

### **How to apply**

1. Complete the online application form addressing the selection criteria and include an itemised budget for travel and accommodation.
