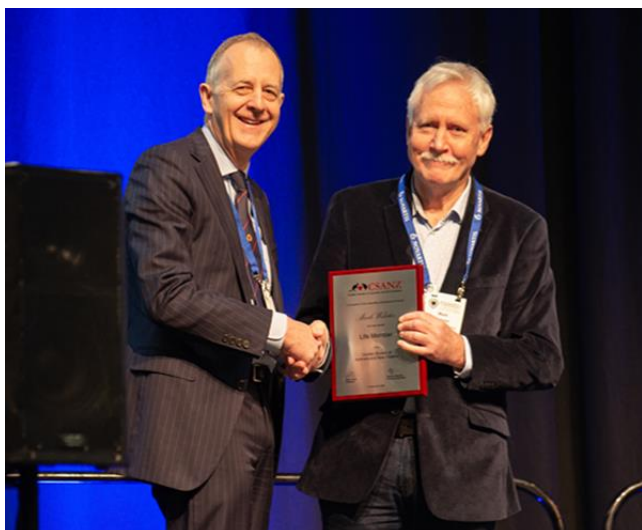
As the program developed, it became clear that equity would be a major theme of the academic content.

The first Tasmanian state CSANZ meeting in at least 15 years was held on Saturday 29th May 2021 at The Grange, Campbell Town.

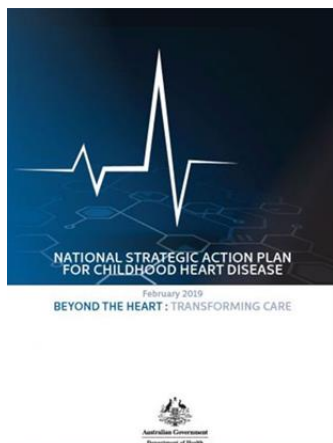

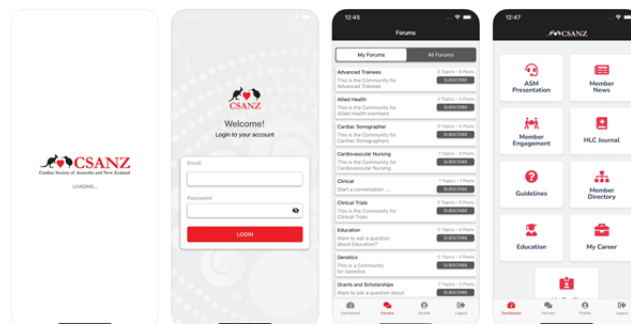
