**Prof David Hare OAM** (VIC) for service to cardiology.

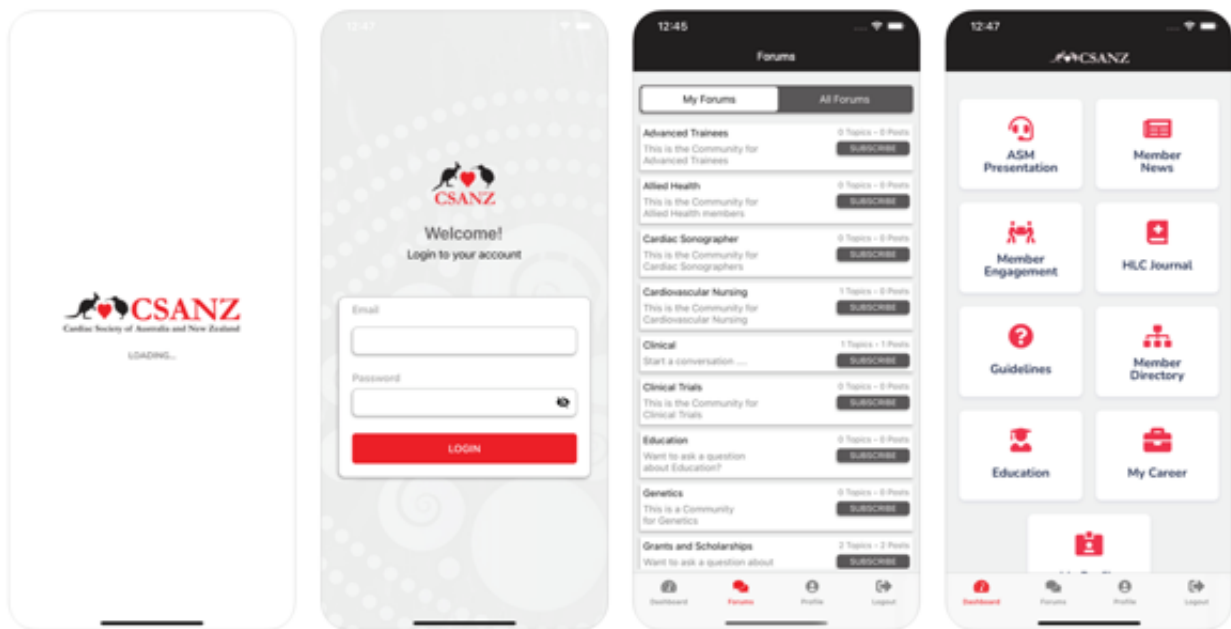
**Prof Igor Konstantinov OAM** (VIC) for service to medicine as a cardiothoracic surgeon.
