CSANZ and HLC Appointments

New MBS items from 1 Nov 2022



On 1 November, 2022 two new MBS items (11736 and 11737) will be introduced for remote monitoring of cardiac ILR devices. These new items will mirror current in-rooms MBS items allowing remote services to be performed. Refer to the **Quick Reference Guide** for further details on **MBS Online**.

In addition, eight MBS items for cardiothoracic surgery items will be amended

Call for nominations for the 2023 R T Hall Prize, the most prestigious research award of CSANZ that recognises the achievements of senior and established investigators.


The Prize is awarded in open competition and is directed towards recognition of sustained and outstanding research achievement.


