EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST

The Conjoint Committee for the Recognition of Training in Cardiac MRI is a joint committee of CSANZ and the Royal Australian and New Zealand College of Radiologists (RANZCR). The Committee comprises three representatives each from CSANZ and RANZCR.

The role of the Committee is to:

- Assess the training and casework of persons seeking recognition of their training and experience in Cardiac MRI.
- Assess the training and casework of providers against the established framework.
- Devise a clear and transparent framework for assessing persons seeking recognition of their training and experience in Cardiac MRI
- Maintain a publicly available register of persons meeting the training requirements established by the Conjoint Committee
- Review the Position Statement on Initial Certification and Recertification for Cardiac MRI

Eligibility criteria:

- Current CSANZ member
- Current accreditation as a CMRI Specialist
- Minimum five years registration as a CRMI Specialist
