Joint Position Statement Diagnosis and Management of Pulmonary Arterial Hypertension Position Statement

The Thoracic Society of Australia and New Zealand and the Cardiac Society of Australia and New Zealand are developing a Joint Position Statement on the **Diagnosis and Management of Pulmonary Arterial Hypertension Position Statement**.

The purpose of the Position Statement is to provide concise, practical and evidence-based recommendations for the diagnosis and management of Pulmonary Arterial Hypertension. This Position Statement will provide a framework to ensure there is consistent standard of care for patients with Pulmonary PAH.

The content of the document will have a broad focus on all aspects of PAH care, including areas such as rehabilitation/exercise training, non-pharmacological measures and psychological support. Thus, the proposed position statement will have utility across a broad range of disciplines.

CSANZ is inviting expressions of interest from the membership to join the Writing Group. The Writing Group will comprise a diverse representation from TSANZ and CSANZ including geographical spread, gender, discipline, and experience.

Main Tasks

- Review literature
- Finalise draft position paper
- Plan implementation and translation

Expected timeframe and scope of work

- 6-12 months
- 3-4 meeting with writing between meetings

Expressions of interest should include:

- A brief description of your reason/s for wishing to join the writing group (100 word limit)
- A brief description of what you can contribute to the writing group (150 word limit)
- Current CV (5 pages limit)
