New and amended PBS listings implemented on 1 Dec 2023

Update to Safety Net Early Supply Rule for 60-day prescriptions of PBS medicines.

Following the Pharmaceutical Benefits Advisory Committee's recommendation, from 1 December 2023, the PBS Safety Net early supply rule will be updated to a 50 day interval (currently 20 days) to discourage stockpiling and reduce the quantity of unused medicines in the community.

The early supply interval for the following 3 items will be updated on 1 January 2024:

- 13550E / nicorandil 10 mg tablet, 60
- 13551F / nicorandil 20 mg tablet, 60
- 13552G / moxonidine 400 microgram tablet, 30

Changes to Online PBS Authorities system

When you use the Services Australia Online PBS Authority system, you will notice changes to the way the system looks and performs - it has improved functionality with the latest updates being made in December 2023. Revised CTCA Training Guidelines

Over the last 12 months the Parent Bodies and Conjoint Committee for CTCA Training Guidelines have reviewed and approved changes to the requirements for CTCA recognition.

The exam is aimed at third year trainees however, second year trainees may also sit the exam. Participation in the exam is completely voluntary and the results do not have any bearing on the completion of your training or obtaining the FRACP.

The course provides key content that has been specifically selected from within the ESC Education section and ESC365 including webinars, congress presentations, ESC guidelines, relevant clinical studies etc. In addition, the course includes a mock exam for candidates to practice using the examination software.

National Cardiac Registry - Scoring runs for Australia!

The National Cardiac Registry (NCR) is a Clinical Quality Registry established in 2019 to **record information on cardiac procedures and devices,** aiming to drive better healthcare outcomes for all Australians. With the combined support of CSANZ and ANZSCTS, the NCR is in good stead to drive the increase of PCI hospital participation and to include cardiac rhythm device implantation in the NCR.

Dr James Leitch, an electrophysiologist and former head of department at John Hunter Hospital, NSW, was appointed **Chair of the NCR board** in October 2023.

Dr Jeffrey Lefkovits, **NCR Steering Committee Chair** said "*Jim is a fantastic addition to the board, his experience and expertise in pacing and electrophysiology will be instrumental in achieving the NCR's ambitious growth goals. We look forward to working with him".*

The NCR Annual Report will be published early in 2024 and will provide insights into performance and outcomes of PCI procedures... the greater the participation the more meaningful this dataset becomes. Thus throughout 2024, the National Cardiac Registry will approach PCI performing hospitals not currently contributing data to the NCR and seek their expressions of interest to participate. Notwithstanding, interested clinicians are encouraged to get in touch to discuss how they may provide data to the NCR, and explore benefits of participating. Led again by Dr Gareth Wynn and Prof Alistair Royse, this unique collaboration between the University of Melbourne's Mobile Learning Unit, CSANZ and PiCSA (Professionals in Cardiac Sciences Australia) brought together Cardiac physiologists and Nurses from across the country for a day combining didactic talks, group discussions and practical stations.

Topics covered ranged from optimising rate response algorithms to making difficult end of life decisions and managing device advisories and had a particular environmental impact focus including a talk on Sustainability in the Cath lab.
