



On Wednesday 27 March, the Australian Cardiac Outcomes Registry (ACOR) attended the South Australian Health and Medical Research Institute (SAHMRI) Registry Centre's annual Symposium, on the topic of 'Value and Impact of Clinical Quality Registries'.

The SAHMRI Registry Centre brings together a collaboration of Registries, including ACOR's Transcatheter Aortic Valve Implantation (TAVI) Registry.

The Registry Centre's 2024 Annual Report was launched at the Symposium, which highlighted the

recent expansion of ACOR's TAVI Registry into the Australian Transcatheter Valve Therapies (ATVT) Registry.

A number of renowned speakers, including international speaker Dr Freddie Bray (Head of Cancer Surveillance Branch at the International Agency for Research on Cancer, World Health Organisation) presented their case studies at the Symposium, demonstrating the positive impact of Clinical Quality Registries on health outcomes, services, and policy.
